How a True Crime Community Helped Rescue a Child

In October 2021, NCMEC received a CyberTipline report containing disturbing child exploitation images. Our analysts worked quickly, identifying details that led to a possible location. **Less than 24 hours later**, law enforcement tracked down the suspect and rescued a young girl from further harm.

A detective working the case later told us:

“Without NCMEC’s incredible work, we wouldn’t have been able to act so quickly. Because of their expertise, a child is now safe, and an offender is behind bars.”
